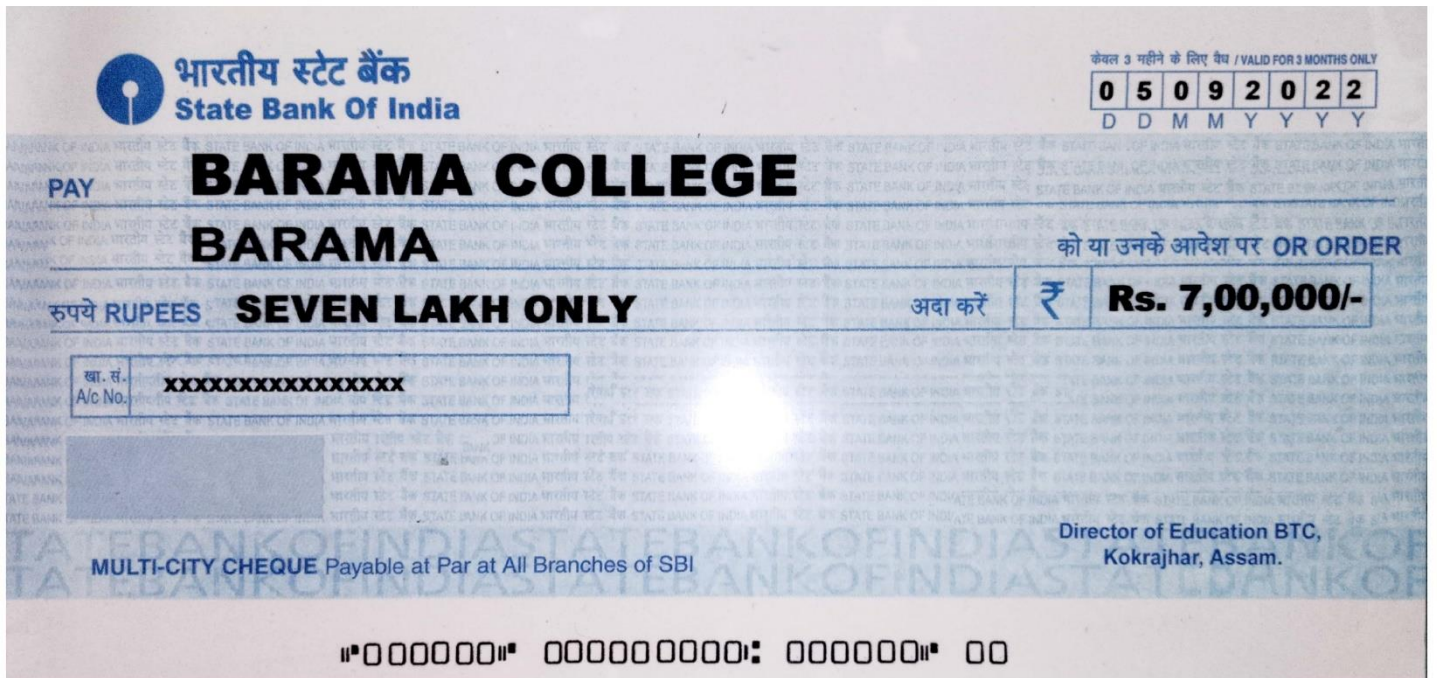

This belief led to the founding of Barama College at Barama on February 5, 1971, initiated by a group of individuals dedicated to promoting higher education for rural students. The primary goal of establishing this college is to foster educational development within the community. But providing quality education isn't the sole purpose of this institution; the necessary effort is also made to preserve unity among diversity.

In line with the NEP2020 policy, Bodoland University- to which Barama College is affiliated at present, like other universities, has adopted the FYUGP (Four Year Undergraduate Programme) course structure, allowing for multi-exit and multi-entry options. Consequently, the college has adopted a multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary approach in its subject offerings. The introduction of this new curriculum aims to support the holistic development of the younger generation. Moreover, parental involvement is crucial in the educational journey, especially as education increasingly takes on a global dimension. For students, acquiring education presents challenges, but it ultimately is an ongoing struggle for parents as well. To meet educational demands and provide necessary facilities, the college authorities have made significant efforts.

Barama College offers undergraduate, postgraduate, and BCA programs, in addition to serving through the Study Center for KKHSOU for both UG and PG distance education programs. The college currently offers postgraduate programs in Bodo and has applied to introduce PG programs in Zoology. Plans also include the addition of Commerce at the undergraduate level.

Barama College occupies a huge resource of 97 bighas of land surrounded by lush forests and picturesque scenery, featuring a variety of flowers, including lilies, roses, and different orchids. The college has 2 girls' hostels with a capacity of 37 seats and 1 boys' hostel with a capacity of 20 seats.

BARAMA COLLEGE: A BRIEF INTRODUCTION

An institution of higher learning was a long cherished dream of the people of greater Baksa area. The dream became reality on 5th Feb 1971, when Barama College was founded under the able leadership of Late Surendra Nath Das, the ex-MLA of 62 Barama (ST) LAC. It was affiliated to the university of Gauhati and was brought under Deficit-Grants-in-Aid System by the Govt. of Assam in 1978. Barama College (Science Stream), which was introduced in 1992, was provincialized by the Govt. of Assam w.e.f 1st January 2013 after its two decades of untiring endeavour. Now the college has 14 full fledged Departments imparting education in both Honours & Regular Courses at the Degree level. The college has been playing a leading role in the sphere of art, culture, science and the development of scientific temper. The college at present has raised one more step towards the educational and cultural prosperity of the greater area. The serene beauty and eco-friendly campus which extends over an area of more than 97 bighas with calm green surroundings is conducive to the pursuit of academic activities.

The college through the various teaching Departments and centre of studies in the campus imparts higher education in the various branches of learning in Arts, Science and Computer Science.

K K Handique State Open University has provided a study centre at Barama College that offers different courses at the HS(BPP), Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) level. Besides, Barama College has introduced a number of professional courses like Mushroom Cultivation Training, Tailoring, Small Scale Chemical Industry etc. with the objectives to make the students capable enough to stand independently in occupational life. At present a proposal is under consideration to start different diploma and certificate courses of Computer Training, GIS(Geographic Information System), Remote Sensing, Language Learning, Entrepreneurship, Vermicompost, etc. A host of dedicated teachers have worked continuously to bring the college to its present prestigious position.

CENTRAL LIBRARY

The Central library of Barama college stands as a beacon of learning, equipped with state-of-the-art facilities and services tailored to meet the academic needs of our students and faculty. The library advocates open access system ensuring ease of access to the resources in the library. The library has an extensive collection of print journals and books including reference books; magazines and daily newspapers. Our library also ensures seamless access to digital resources including e-books and e-journals through N-LIST subscription of INFLIBNET and support academic endeavours.

LIBRARY FACILITIES AND SERVICES

TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE

The library is equipped with high-speed internet access, computers, scanner and printing facilities. The library uses SOUL 2.0 software in the library for library management and automation. With the help of SOUL 2.0 software in the library, the students and faculty can effortlessly search for books and journals using personalized browsing options through OPAC.

RFID TECHNOLOGY

Our library employs cutting-edge RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) technology for efficient management of resources. RFID tags are embedded in library materials, allowing for swift check-in and check-out processes, thus minimizing wait times and enhancing user experience. Additionally, RFID tags help prevent theft and a loss by providing real-time tracking and security alerts.

DSPACE

The library has integrated DSpace, a digital repository software, which serves as a centralized platform for the institution for storing, preserving and disseminating digital materials, including research papers, question papers, college magazines and other multimedia content.



STUDY AREA

Our library provides ample study spaces equipped with proper lighting and ventilation conducive for both collaborative study and solitary learning for the users. Separate reading area are provided for both the faculty staff and the students.

LABORATORY

The college has six well-equipped laboratories with updated facilities separately for the Departments of Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Zoology, Education and Geography. The process of providing special power supply facility to all these laboratories will be completed very soon. Besides these, there is a computer laboratory having internet facility to provide necessary infrastructure for the students of Computer Science.

AUDITORIUM

The newly constructed 'Auditorium' is completed and it is one of the largest in its kind in BTAD. It is equipped with sophisticated light and sound system having capacity of 2000 seats. All the cultural programmes and other needs are taking place at the auditorium throughout the year. The college has also a well-equipped Teachers' Conference Hall and a Principal's Conference Hall, equipped with sound system, attached to the Principal's Chamber, for holding meetings with the Principal.

NCC

In 1987 NCC (in army wing) was introduced at Barama College under 2nd Lieutenant Khagen Das, Lect. Dept of Geography. At Present it is run by Sri Cittaranjan Muchahary, Asst. Prof. Dept. of Bodo. Sri Cittarnajan Muchahary, has completed PRCN/161/2016 course from OTA (Officers' Training Academy), Kampta, Maharashtra and received the designation of Lieutenant as ANO Associate NCC Officer.

Another unit of NCC under 30 Assam Bn. was introduced at Barama College in December, 2020. Mr. Biju Pathak Assistant Professor, Dept. of English is CTO of that Unit.

N.S.S

In 1972 NSS was introduced at Barama College, under the abled leadership of Sri Ramani Kanta Saharia , Lect. Dept of Political Science and since then it has been providing yeoman service to the student of the institution. Under the leadership of Mr. Makibar Rahman, the NSS unit upgraded to two NSS units, namely Barama College, NSS Unit I and Barama College NSS Unit II. At present the Unit I and Unit II are guided by Dr. Ratul Das, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Geography and Dr. Jayanta Kr. Das, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Zoology respectively.

GAMES AND SPORTS

The college campus is equipped with a big play ground for outdoor games. Here football, volley ball, cricket and other track and field events are practiced regularly. Till now there is no gymnasium hall, but we have plan to start it very soon. There is also Girls' Common Room with different indoor games facilities. Another significant feature of the sport facilities provided by the college is the Indoor Stadium which is completed and opened for playing indoor games.

CAREER COUNSELLING CELL

A cell for career counselling to the students is also functioning. This helps the students in selecting their future course of action regarding higher education, placement and job avenues are being encouraged.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

There is a Grievance Redressal cell in the college to look into the grievance of the students, guardians and employees. The aggrieved person/body needs to apply to the Principal, the president of the cell and the cell resolves the grievance of the parties

STUDENTS' AID FUND

Poor but meritorious students who do not get any scholarship are granted monetary help from this aid fund. This aid is disbursed by a committee after screening the application of the applicant.

STUDENTS ASSOCIATION

A full-fledged students association under the name of B.C.S.U.S exists in the college which is a constitutionally elected body. The executive body elected for a session and a new committee is elected after the session is over.

EXTENSION EDUCATION CELL







This cell provides training to the students in different events for self employment. At present it is providing short term trainings in the field of computer, sericulture, fishery management, chemical preparation, mushroom cultivation vermicompost, language learning, GIS remote sensing, etc.

PROCTORIAL SYSTEM

The students are divided into number of groups and their overall activities during the whole period of course are invigilated and reported to the authority by certain teachers engaged separately. Any observed inconvenience due to valid reason is taken into account and effort is made to resolve the inconvenience, and students are encouraged with facilities provided by the college authority.

MONITORING OF ACADEMIC PROGRESS

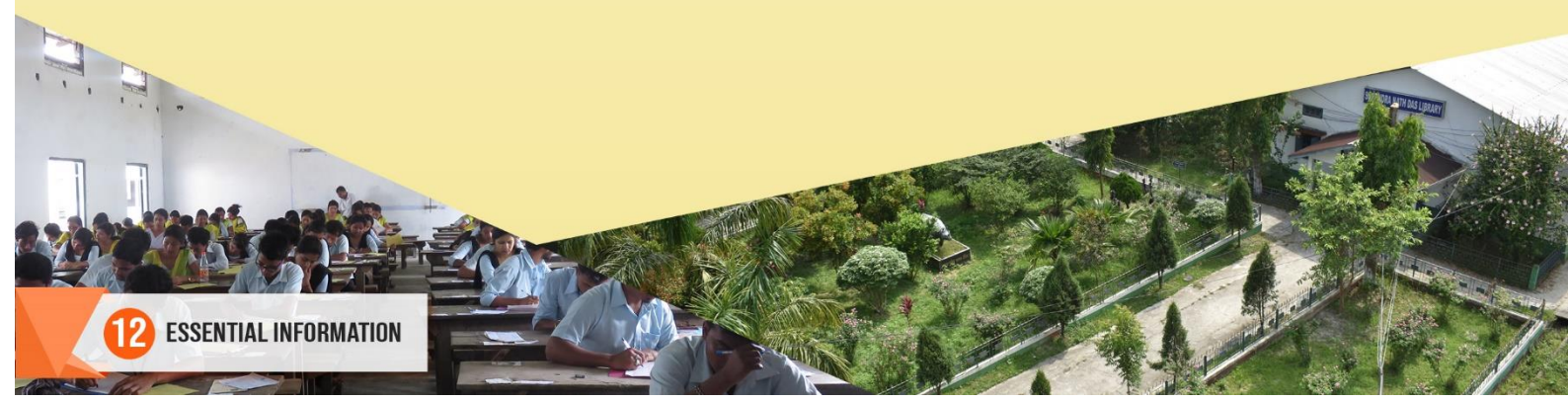

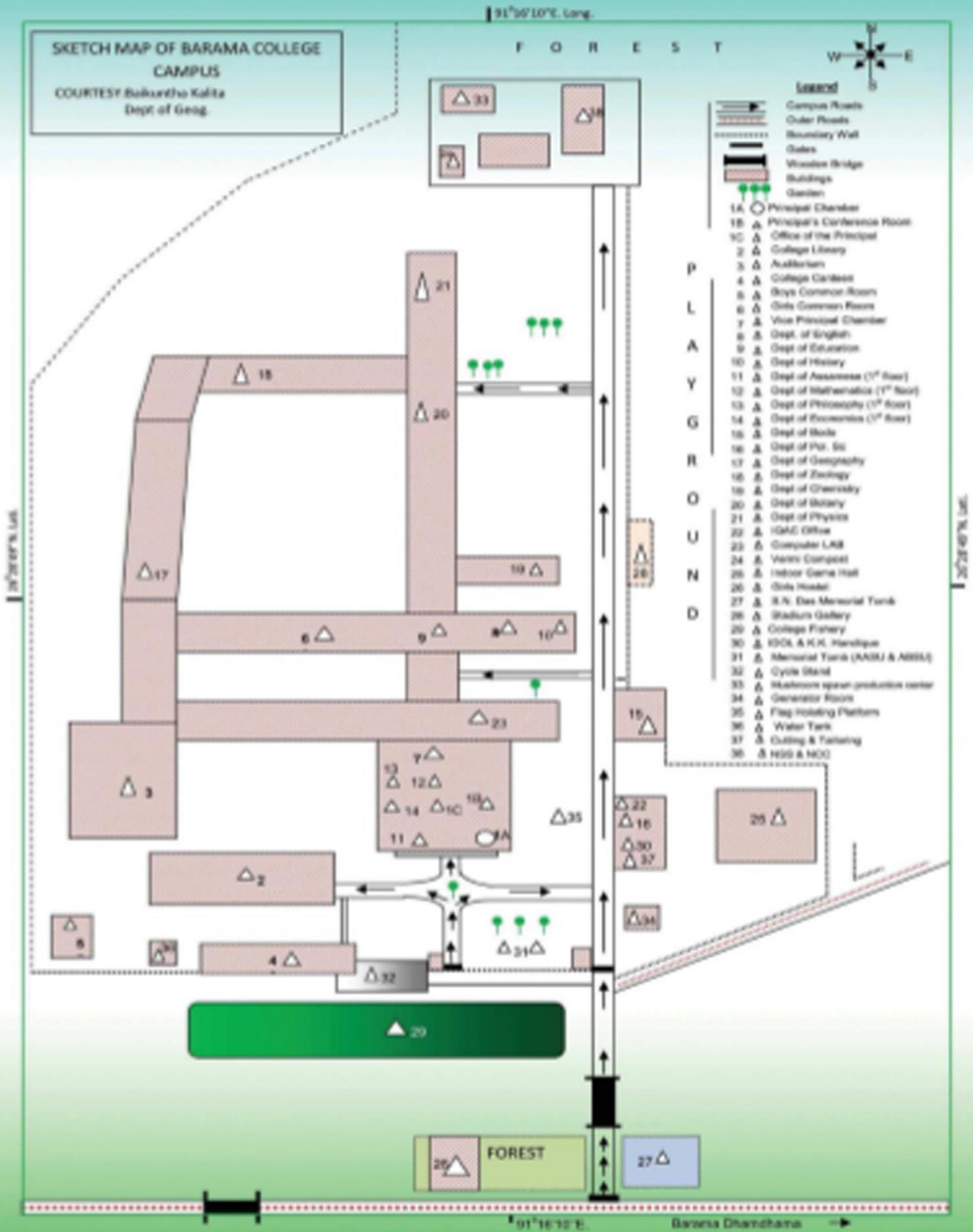
